



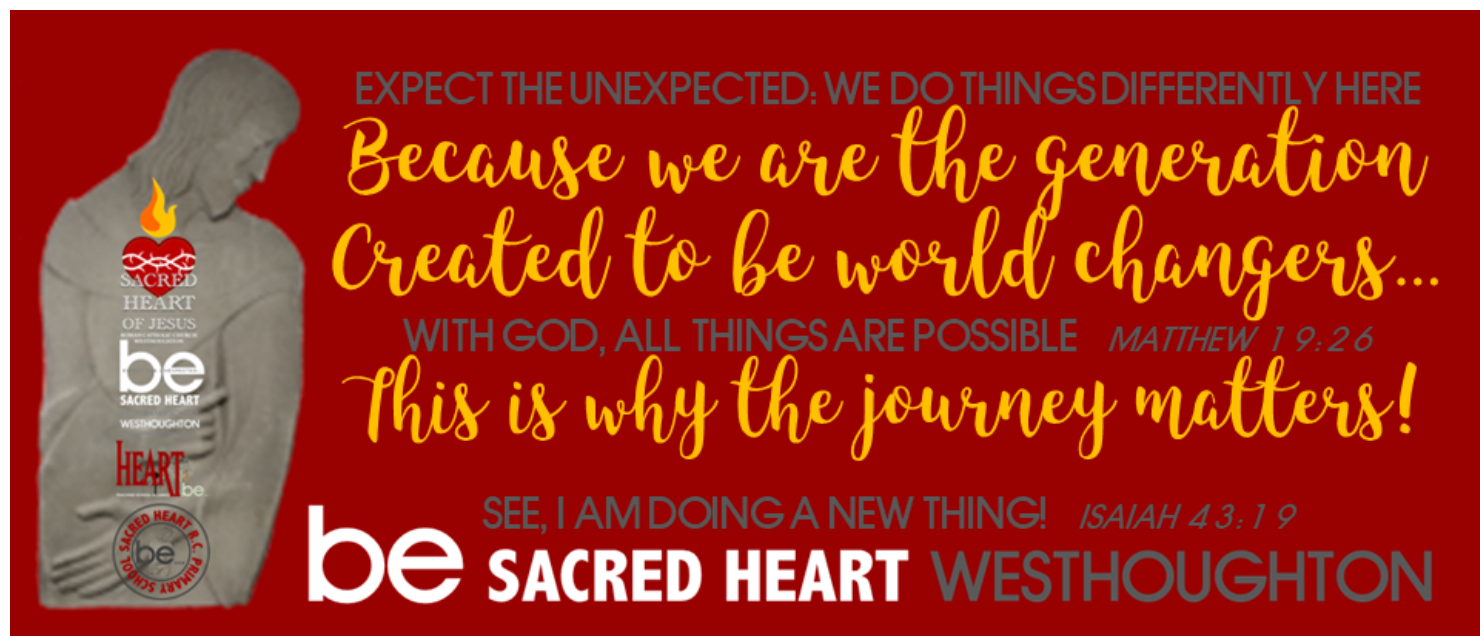

APPOINTMENTS: Should you wish to come into school to speak to a member of staff, this must be arranged via the main office, who will then get back to you with a suitable appointment time. It is not usually possible to speak to your child's teacher after the morning bell, when they will be focused on the learning and teaching in their class, so urgent messages for that same day should be sent in by note handed by your child to the teacher, or the member of staff on the door. The first point of contact if you have any questions about your child's learning or personal development, should be their class teacher(s). If this does not resolve the situation, you will be referred to the Assistant Headteacher or senior leader in that Key Stage, who has an overview of all children's progress and development. Finally, you may be asked to have a meeting with the Deputy Headteacher or Headteacher [Mrs Callow or Mr Johnson].

PARK & WALK CODE:

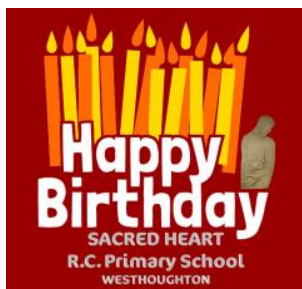
1. Adhere to the one way system to avoid any confusion and accidents, parking safely on one of the designated numbers.
2. Get out of the car and deliver your child safely to the main playground. They must not return to the **PARK & WALK** zone. If collecting, you must walk to the main playground, and not remain in your car or stand in the **PARK & WALK** zone.
3. When leaving the car park please do so in a safe way. Our speed limit is **5** mph.
4. Please do not enter the **PARK & WALK** zone after 8.50am / 3:35pm to avoid collisions with cars leaving the area.

SCHOOL MEALS: Meals are provided at no cost to families for children in Reception, Y1 & Y2. For KS2 children, the cost of school meals is £1.40 per day. Meals are ordered on a term-by-term basis. The cost for this half term is **£44.80** which will cover from Wednesday 11th April – Friday 25th May, less one day for the bank holiday. Next half term is **£46.20** Monday 4th June – Wednesday 18th July. Cheques should be made payable to BMBC, and sent to the main office.

Bolton Council School Meals Sacred Heart Primary Menu : May – October 2018

Dear Parent or Guardian,

Did you know that choosing healthy school food will not only save you time and money, but will provide your child with a delicious and nutritious meal that will support their development and education.



Menu Choices

The healthy food choices on the May-October 2018 Menu complies with the Government's School Food Standards, which are intended to help children develop healthy eating habits and ensure they get the energy and nutrition they need.

Food Standards

The highlighted dishes are some of the foods which must meet the food standards

Blue – meat product restricted to once a week.

Pink – pastry restricted to twice a week.

Red – breaded items or fried, restricted to twice a week.

Purple – oily fish must be served once a week.

"My child wasn't prepared to try anything at home. We worried he wasn't eating enough, he wouldn't touch fruit or vegetables and would only eat white bread. When he see his friends having new food as part of their school meal he tries them too, so he doesn't feel left out. If he's sitting with his friends who are eating, he seems to eat more."



Universal Infant Free School Meals

All children in Key Stage 1 are entitled to a free school meal. You do not need to register for this free meal entitlement, but your school receives funding based on entitlement to welfare benefit free school meals, so please register for these if you are eligible.

Allergen Information

Allergen information can be obtained by talking to our staff or visiting the school meals website.

Excellent Value for Money

The price of a school meal in Bolton is just £1.40, excellent value for a two course meal including a drink. Your child may be entitled to a free school meal, visit the website for further details.
