



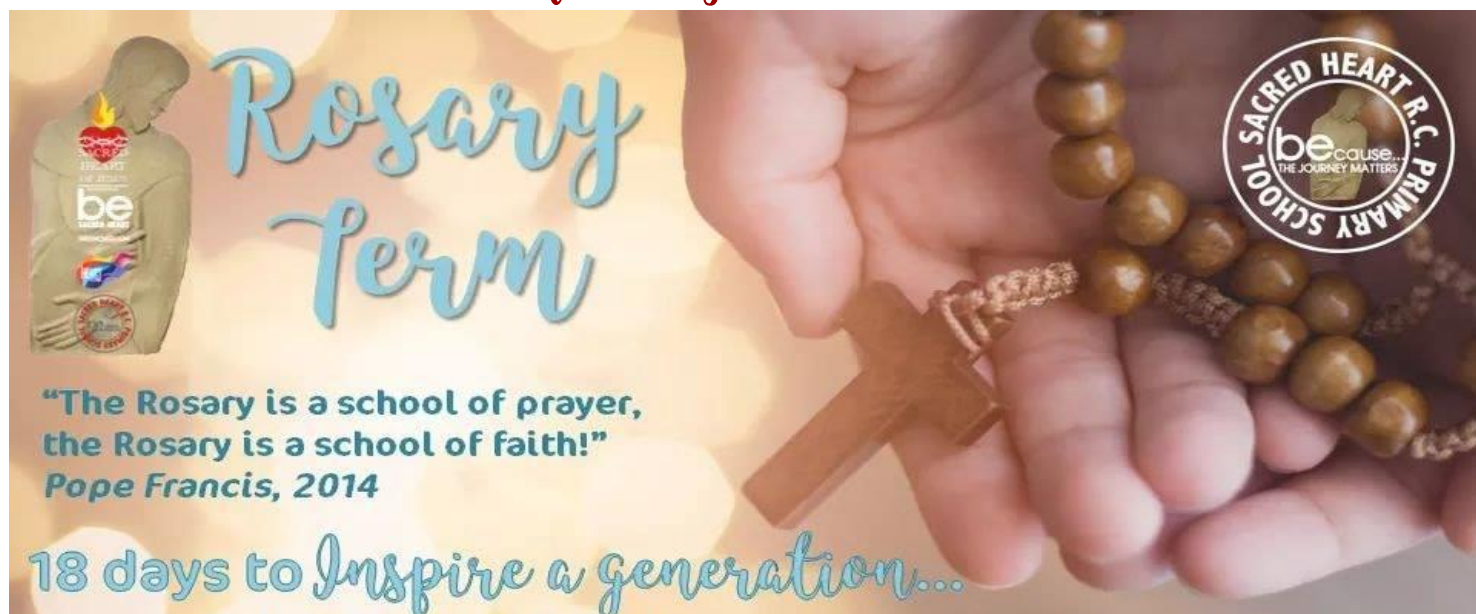

Y6 SATS WEEK: With this week being SATs Week, we wish all those doing tests in this season of May good luck.
