Dear Parents & Families,

SCHOOL MEALS: Meals are provided at no cost to families for children in Reception, Y1 & Y2. For KS2 children, the cost of school meals is currently £1.80 per day. Meals are ordered on a half-termly basis. The cost for this half term will be £52.20 which covers 19th April 2021 to 28th May 2021.

The cost for meals next half term will be £61.20 which covers 7th June 2021 to 22nd July 2021.

Cheques should be made payable to BMBC, and sent to the main office. Please ensure that you inform the office prior to changing your child's meal arrangements.

COVID-19: Please note, any Covid-19 related communication linked to isolation requirements or testing **MUST** be sent to covid@sacred-heart.bolton.sch.uk Any children off school isolating must be completing work set by Google Classrooms, unless they are poorly.

CLOAKROOMS: At the moment our cloakrooms are closed due to Covid-19, and the children are keeping their bags and coats on their chair in the classroom. It is now more important than ever, that we try to reduce the size of our bags as space for their belongings is limited.

The children need only a PE bag, and a book bag. The book bags are needed for the child's reading book and their lunch. Smaller bags like these fit under their chair easily, and once we are able to reopen the cloakrooms again, these bags will hang on their pegs easily and leave room for others.

Pencil cases, if they have one, are to be kept in trays in the classroom and should not be brought into school daily (again this is part of our risk assessment). We know that some children will be bringing in their musical instruments on the day that they have lessons with our peripatetic teachers too.
