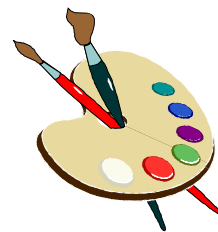




Westhoughton Rotary Club Junior Art Competition 2025 RULES, GUIDELINES & PRIZES



Competition for Westhoughton Primary School pupils in Years 3 & 5

The topic for year three pupils is:

My favourite game: it can be any type of game, indoor or outdoor

An illustration of whichever you enjoy most.

The topic for year five pupils is:

Winter: A painting or coloured drawing which sums up this time of year.

The size of entries to be no larger than A3.

Individual schools to select what they consider the best four pieces of work of each year group to be submitted to a panel of judges selected by the Rotary Club.

Each piece of work must have the pupil's name, year group & school **ON THE BACK** please.

The entries will be collected on the morning of **Wednesday 12th March 2025**.

When all entries have been collected, the judges will select which in their opinion is the best work of art and a second and third in each year group. The judges' decisions will be final.

SCHOOL PRIZES

year 3 - £100

Prize money of one hundred pounds going to the school which in the opinion of the judges submitted the best painting in year three.

year 5 - £100

Prize money of one hundred pounds going to the school which in the opinion of the judges submitted the best painting in year five.

INDIVIDUAL PRIZES

The individual prizes of ten pounds to the overall winning pupils in both age groups with further prizes of five pounds going to pupils who submit paintings which are considered second and third in both age groups.

year 3 - 1st £10 - 2nd & 3rd £5 each

year 5 - 1st £10 - 2nd & 3rd £5 each
